PROTECTED INDUSTRIAL ACTION POSTERS AND STICKERS

Is this action lawful?

Yes. The placement of official AFPA stickers and posters is deemed lawful protected industrial action (PIA).

Where can I place posters and stickers?

Stickers and posters can be placed wherever you deem suitable. Focus on high traffic areas such as lifts and entrances and exits where people will see them. Please remember that permanent damage to surfaces can't occur, so consider if a sticker or poster is appropriate for the area you wish to place it.

Stickers and posters must not obscure, damage or interfere with any AFP material already in place.

I've run out of stickers and posters, what do I do?

Can I take photographs of the stickers and posters?

100% YES. We strongly encourage you to take photos and send them to the AFPA via eaafpa@afpa.org.au. Photos will be used on official AFPA social media channels and provided to journalists to increase media exposure.

Where can I take photographs?

Be creative and take photos with nice and interesting backdrops. When taking the photo, please consider what and who is in the background. Maintain operational security. Also, please don't place yourself or the community in danger while taking photos.


Do I have to time record putting up a poster or sticker?

Yes, even if placing a sticker or poster takes 10 seconds, you are required to time record this activity. Members must promptly and accurately record their PIA in the appropriate time recording system
