PROTECTED INDUSTRIAL ACTION LANYARDS AND WRISTBANDS

Is this action lawful?

Yes. The wearing of official AFPA lanyards and wristbands is deemed lawful protected industrial action (PIA).

Can I wear a wristband and lanyard while at work?

Yes, we strongly encourage you to wear a lanyard and wristband while at work or on duty.

I've run out of lanyards and wristbands, what do I do?

Can I take photographs of the wristbands and lanyards?

100% YES. We strongly encourage you to take photos and send them to the AFPA via eaafpa@afpa.org.au. Photos will be used on official AFPA social media channels and provided to journalists to increase media exposure.

Where can I take photographs?

Be creative and take photos with nice and interesting backdrops. When taking the photo, please consider what and who is in the background. Also, please don't place yourself or the community in danger while taking photos.

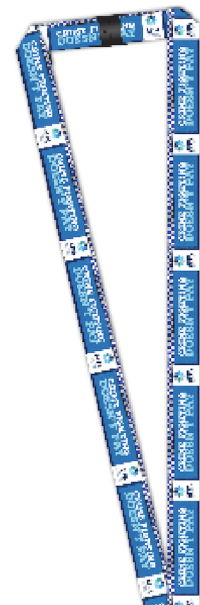
Do I have to time record putting on a lanyard or wristband?

Yes, even if putting on a wristband or lanyard takes 3 seconds, you are required to time record this activity. Members must promptly and accurately record their PIA in the appropriate time recording system
